



Quick Reference Guide

Once logged in to your account, navigate through OTNhub to access information about the tools and services to best support your practice, according to the role you play in the healthcare system.

- 1 Navigate to the homepage from anywhere on the OTNhub by clicking on the OTNhub logo.
- 2 OTN tools and services have been organized into **Patient Care** and **Professional Development** streams. Click in each stream to navigate to the relevant area on the page.
- 3 "What's New" section will provide information about recent updates, news and changes in the hub and at OTN. You can navigate to this section by scrolling down the page or clicking on the news icon.
- 4 In the **Patient Care** section, you will be able to find links to applications and resources for programs that OTN offers: **eConsult**, **eVisit** and **eCare**.



* eConsult

Consult with specialists in over 27 areas of care. Send data easily and securely from your PC, Mac or mobile device. Receive a response in 3 to 5 days.



* eVisit

Arrange real-time video visits with patients and peers. And choose the method that's best for you: Room-based, PC, Mac or mobile.



* eCare

Use apps and other devices to monitor patients or coach them to manage their condition at home.

ePodium

Attend live learning events from providers on a range of topics via video. OTN also hosts its own professional learning sessions on clinical topics.
