



BECOMING A CONSULTING TELESTROKE NEUROLOGIST

To participate in the Ontario Telestroke Program, a neurologist must:

- Have completed a fellowship in stroke and/or be on staff at a Regional Stroke Centre;
- Actively be taking acute stroke call at an Ontario hospital;
- Be a member in good standing with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario;
- Be willing to use the current telemedicine service offering;
- Be willing to use Emergency Neuro Image Transfer System (ENITS) for CT/CTA image access;
- Be willing to undergo technology and Telestroke protocol training; and
- Be willing to participate in a call schedule, taking a minimum of four, 24-hour call shifts (two primary and two back-up) per month.

Applying to become a Telestroke neurologist:
